Many thanks for applying for a tour of the ARC. We are delighted to hear from you; everyone loves a real hands-on visit! One day, we promise!

We have a video tour of the ARC in the making, but it's been put on hold! As an alternative at the current time we are pleased to offer you a virtual visit from the archivist and/or a member of her team. This can be during a unit meeting; we can host a zoom meeting if required.

Additionally, we are pleased to offer this visit on the theme of Curative Curating from the guide section UMAs, which also means you can tick off that box too! We can also adapt for brownie Museum of imagination.

If you would like to do that the girls need to bring the following please:

- ♣ pencil, paper, and a backdrop (something to hold behind an object when photographing it - could be a towel, or scarf or cloth)
- ♣ Something to remind them of lockdown
- ♣ In their head, their favourite museum

During the meeting the girls will contribute to a display about living in lockdown. They will create a label and take a photo of their display to be included in your unit's virtual museum. It would be helpful if a leader could support by giving object numbers to individuals on the night. More details will be given but they will follow the museum format, i.e. NFKGG.2021.xxxx where x are unique numbers to be assigned to displays. There are opportunities for the girls to contribute during the session; it is helpful if they have their actual names on display. Also it might be easiest if you could call on the girls to answer questions; it isn't always possible to see them whilst sharing the screen! Thank you for your help. Participants will be asked to take a photo of their object and label set on a background. Please will you accept these and then forward to me to save in our time capsule and hopefully post on Facebook too. That is why we don't ask for photos of display with the girls in them. Thank you.

By doing this activity, plus a few more, the girls/leaders may also choose to achieve their Living in Lockdown badge! This will be free; more details can be found at
